Aims

This first summer school organized by EDiSo seeks to create a space for intense discussion around theoretical and methodological issues in contemporary discourse studies. It is designed for postgraduate students, doctoral students and early career researchers (ECRs) of any discipline (Linguistics, Communication, Sociology, Anthropology, Education, Psychology, Humanities, etc.) with a central interest in examining discourse from a social perspective. The summer school schedule will facilitate formal and informal spaces for joint discussion, data analysis and networking. The two academic sessions of the school include:

- Lectures
- Reading groups
- Manuscript mentoring
- Data analysis workshops
- Research presentations

Venue - Enrollment - Fees

This a residential summer school that will be held at the *Residencia La Cristalera* - Universidad Autónoma de Madrid (<http://lacristalera.com>). Registration includes travel to the site from UAM Cantoblanco Campus and return trip to downtown Madrid at the end of the summer school, accommodation for two nights and full board during the summer school (from dinner 1 July 2020 to lunch on 3 July 2020). The cost for the summer school is **154 euros**, which covers full lodging at *Residencia La Cristalera*. There will not be any other additional fees. EDiSo will finance all other expenses related to the organization of summer school and will offer a few bursaries to facilitate participation. There are 20 places available in the summer school.



How to apply

Students and ERCs interested in participating in the summer school must submit an admission application containing the following information / documentation:

- (1) A text (maximum length: 700 words) that summarizes the academic and professional trajectory of the applicant, with special emphasis on the contribution the summer school can make to the applicant's training.
- (2) Title and abstract of the paper that the applicant will present in the summer school (maximum length: 500 words). This paper must be original and discuss ongoing research.
- (3) In the case of requesting assistance for participation in the summer school, applicants will have to fill out the form attached to this message.
- (4) One of the activities of the summer school will be a mentoring / feedback session for manuscripts in progress. Participants in the summer school will be asked to circulate a manuscript draft approximately one month before the summer school.

The documents contained in (1), (2) and (3) must be sent in a single file in pdf format to the summer school coordination (Eva Codó, Miguel Pérez-Milans, Bernardino Tavares, David Poveda and Manuel Alcántara) to the email address escuelaediso2020@gmail.com **before March 1, 2020.**
